MISSION OUTREACH– STAMP MINISTRY

Hope Circle, at Gaylord UMC, is still collecting, trimming and shipping old and used postage stamps to Alliance Stamp Ministry in Fort Myers, FL. They sell the stamps to stamp collectors and raise money to buy Spanish language Sunday School materials for poor churches in Central America, South America and even in the USA. Since 1972, when they started the ministry, they have raised \$858,361. Hope Circle sends one or two boxes per year to them.
