Recipe of the Month

CARROT CAKE OATMEAL COOKIES**INGREDIENTS:**

1 cup of flour	
1/2 tsp. baking soda	1/2 cup(1 stick) unsalted butter. Soften
1/4 tsp. Salt	1/2 cup packed light brown sugar
1 tsp. Ground ginger	1/4 cup granulated sugar
1 tsp. Cinnamon	1 large egg at room temperature
	1 tsp. Pure vanilla extract
	3/4 cup lightly packed freshly grated carrots
	1/3 cup raisins
	1/3 cup chopped walnuts or pecans

DIRECTIONS:

1. Line two large baking sheets with parchment paper and set aside.
2. In a large mixing bowl, whisk together the flour, soda, salt, cinnamon, ginger until well combined. Stir in the old fashioned rolled oats and set aside.
3. In the bowl using a handheld mixer beat the butter, brown sugar, and granulated sugar together for 1-2 minutes or until well combined.
4. Mix in the egg and vanilla until fully combined.
5. Mix in the dry ingredients until just combined, then fold in the grated carrots, raisins and nuts.
6. Use a 1Tbsp cookie scoop, scoop the cookie dough onto the prepared baking sheets. Leave a little room between each one. Gently press each ball of cookie dough down to slightly flatten it.
7. Bake at 350 for 12-15 minutes or until the tops of the cookies are set and the edges are lightly browned . Remove from the oven and allow the cookies to cool for 5 minutes before removing from the cookie sheet.

Makes 22 cookies.
