From the United Methodist Council of Bishops: Pentecost People: Transformed by the Holy Spirit

What is God calling us as congregations of The United Methodist Church to be at this time in history?

Throughout our worldwide connection, there are vibrant congregations; the good news is being preached; the hungry are being fed; prisoners are being visited; the sick are being cared for; the marginalized are finding a home; migrants and refugees are being welcomed; people are coming to faith; UMCOR and other agencies have been engaged in disaster relief; churches are being planted; justice is being pursued; evil, injustice, and oppression are being resisted; and communities are being transformed.

The 2020 (which happened in 2024) General Conference marked a new beginning for The UMC. As we live into this new church, we long for the spiritual renewal of the church, a new Pentecost: the transforming presence of the Spirit of God amongst us in a new way. We desire to rediscover what it means to be Pentecost People – people healed and transformed by the presence of the Holy Spirit, sharing in the death and resurrection of Christ, living in dynamic, welcoming communities, empowered to bear witness in example, deeds, and word to God's reign of love in the world. This eight-week program is designed as a resource for the church to learn what it means to be people waiting for a new Pentecost.

John Wesley strongly argued that waiting for grace, the active presence of the Spirit, is an active waiting. We do not sit around doing nothing. We engage ourselves in preparing for the coming of God's grace. More than that, this preparing for the coming of God's grace is, in fact, the consequence of God's grace already present and active within us. Active waiting does not mean that we try to earn God's grace, that we can compel God to act, or that there is even a direct relationship between our actions and God's actions. Active waiting is a preparing of the way, inspired and empowered by God, for the Spirit to do something surprisingly new.
